- Dr. R. Chitra enquired whether the Language Elective course is mandatory for all students. Dr. G. Anusha informed that students will have the option to choose one of the Language Elective based on their preference.

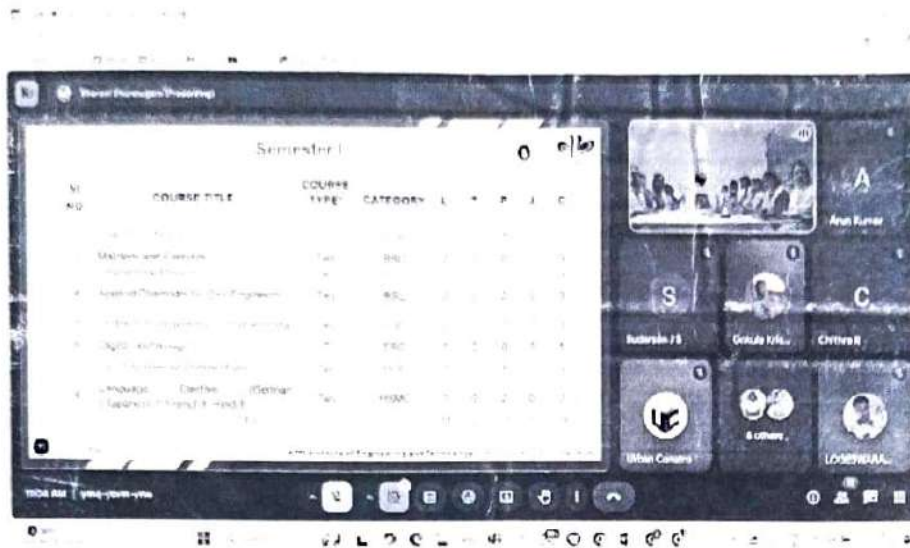
3. Gathering inputs from members for Curriculum of Regulation R 2025 UG programme - III to VIII Sem


- Er Arunkumar suggested to shift Structural Analysis I from Semester V to Semester IV.
- Dr J S Sudarsan and Er Arunkumar suggested changing Climate change and Mitigation from Semester VII as a Professional Elective and include Rehabilitation and Retrofitting of structure as a core course.
- Dr R Chitra enquired about the mandatory internship in the upcoming curriculum. Dr G Anusha informed that the students will undertake internship for four weeks during semester III to VI.
- Dr J S Sudarsan suggested to include bar bending schedule and AR/VR in the upcoming curriculum. Mrs R Kavitha informed that bar bending schedule will be included in the syllabus of Quantity surveying and costing.
- Dr J S Sudarsan suggested to include the PowerBI tool as value added course to students and Gateway based teaching to students for possible subjects.
- Er R Gokula Krishnan suggested to include design project to students during Semester VII.
