Introduction

The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps.

KPR Institute of Engineering and Technology raised 5 (TN) Girls BN NCC Unit - Senior Wing from October 2018, 6 (TN) Med Coy NCC and 2 (TN) Air Sqn NCC from 2021,2(TN) Naval Unit NCC from 2024 and has many active functioning in the campus from its inception. The units coordinate and conduct various Camps, social service-based activities, etc.

Introduction:

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the youth wing of the Indian Armed Forces with its headquarters in New Delhi, India. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis as a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, the Navy and the Air Force. Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and drill. Officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course.

After Independence, the present day NCC formally came into existence on 15 July 1948 through XXXI Act of Parliament. The Girls Division of NCC was raised in July 1949. On 01 April 1950, Air Wing was raised with one Air squadron each at Bombay and Kolkata. The Naval Wing of the NCC was raised in July 1952, thus representing all three services in the Corps.

Today the NCC has an enrolled strength of more than 13 Lakh cadets and consists of two divisions of all three services i.e. the Senior Division/ Senior Wing for boys/girls from colleges and the Junior Division/Junior Wing for boys/girls from schools.

KPR Institute of Engineering and Technology has been actively fostering a culture of discipline, leadership and community service through its National Cadet Corps (NCC) units. The Institute initiated its first NCC unit, 5(TN) GIRLS BN NCC in October 2018, aimed at empowering female students with opportunities for personal growth and national service.

Extending its commitment to the NCC program, the institute subsequently established the 6(TN) MED COY NCC and the 2(TN) AIR SQN NCC in 2021. These units play a vital role in channeling the energy and talents of students towards constructive activities that benefit both the campus community and society at large.

Aims of NCC:

The aims of NCC are mainly three fold:-

- a) To develop following qualities in the cadets
 - i. Character
 - ii. Comradeship
 - iii. Discipline
 - iv. Secular Outlook
 - v. Spirit of Adventure
 - vi. Ideals of selfless service
- b) To create a human resource of organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all walks of life who will serve the nation regardless of which career they choose.
- c) To provide an environment conductive to motivating young Indians to choose the Armed Forces as their career.

The Motto of NCC is "Unity and Discipline" i.e. (Ekta aur Anushasan)

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) instils several core values among its cadets, fostering qualities that are essential for personal development and contributing positively to the society. Here are the core values of NCC:



Introduction

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the Indian military cadet corps headquartered in New Delhi. It is open to school and college students on a voluntary basis. The NCC is a voluntary organization that recruits cadets from high schools, colleges, and universities across India. Cadets receive basic military training in small arms and drills. While officers and cadets have no liability for active military service upon completion of their training, they are given preference over other candidates during selection processes based on their achievements in the corps.

KPR Institute of Engineering and Technology established the 5 (TN) Girls Battalion NCC Unit – Senior Wing in October 2018, the 6 (TN) Medical Company NCC and the 2 (TN) Air Squadron NCC in 2021, and the 2 (TN) Naval Unit NCC in November 2023.
